The Creation Story

Creation is vitally important to understanding the Bible. It answers questions like:

Is there a Creator? How did we get here? Where did we come from? Why are we here? Do we have a purpose? God also demonstrates His creative powers throughout the Bible.

Activity: Fill out the Creation Sheet using Genesis 1:1 – 2:3

What did God create? Which verse(s) record this? How does this affect/ help us today? What was God's response?

Discuss the various benefits of the creation God has made. How does God's creation affect you today? Do you think that God could have created everything in 6 days?

- 3 How are those who "belong to Christ" described?
