Read the following passages, then answer the questions. Take note of words and phrases you don't understand.

#### Section 1: The Tower of Babel Read Genesis 11: 1-9

- 1. What command did God give Noah and his descendants? Review <u>Genesis 9:1,7</u> What did the people living in Babel decide to do?
- 2. What kind of attitude do you think people had in Genesis 11:4?
- 3. What was God's response to this? How did this affect the people then and today?

#### Section 2: Abraham, a Man of Faith Read Genesis 11: 27-32

4. Where was Abram born? Who was Abram's wife's name and what was her problem?

#### Read Genesis 12: 1-4

- 5. What command and what promises did God give to Abram? Why might God's promise seem difficult for Abraham to believe? Why might we find it difficult to trust God today?
- 6. How are all the families of the world blessed through Abraham? Read Galatians 3:16. How do we become sons of God, Galatians 3:26?
- 7. How would you feel if God told you to leave your home country?

#### Read Galatians 3:6,7

8. How did God count Abraham as righteous? What do you think righteous means? How did Abraham show faith? Who are the real "children of Abraham?"

#### **Section 3: Promise** <u>Read Genesis 15:3-6</u>

- 9. Who was Abraham going to make his heir? What promise did God give to Abraham and Sarah? Why is this promise unusual?
  - Note: We know that Abraham was about 75 years old at the time, and Sarah was only 10 years younger that Abraham.

#### Read Genesis 16:1-4

- 10. What was Sarah's plan to help God? Do you think this was wise?
- 11. Was this God's plan or man's plan? Did this plan come from faith or from a lack of faith?

### Read Genesis 16:11-12

- 12. Who is the son born from Sarah's plan and what is his importance today?
  - Note: The Arab people are descended from Ishmael.

#### Read Genesis 21:1-5

- 13. How old were Abraham and Sarah at the time of the birth of Isaac?
- 14. What do you think that we can we learn about God from this story?
- 15. How is God calling us to have faith today? Why do you think God wants us to have faith in Him? Read Ephesians 2:8-10
- 16. Read Hebrews 11:1,6-8 What does this say faith is? Do you have faith in God? Why?
