The Gospel of Luke - Lesson 2,

Luke 1:26-55

An Angel Appears to Mary

In this passage, an angel appears to a young Jewish woman called Mary. The angel announced that Mary would become pregnant by the Holy Spirit and give birth to Jesus.

Read Luke 1:26-38

- 1. How many months have passed since Elizabeth's pregnancy began.
- 2. What was the name of the angel sent to Mary? Where was Mary living? Who was Mary engaged to, and who was he descended from?
- 3. How did Mary feel when the angel appeared? Do you see any similarities between Mary and Zechariah's response to the angel's appearance? How did the angel calm Mary?
- 4. What did the angel say was going to happen to Mary? What would be the child's name? Does verse 33 surprise you? Why?
- 5. How did the angel say that Mary would become pregnant? Whose son would the child be?
- 6. What was Mary's attitude about this news? Does her attitude surprise you?

Read Luke 1:39-55

- 7. Where did Mary go after receiving this news?
- 8. What did Elizabeth's baby do inside her?
- 9. What did Elizabeth think about Mary's news in verse 42?
- 10. Why does Elizabeth think that Mary is blessed? Why is belief so important to God?
- 11. Verses 46-55 are a song that Mary sang. Sometimes it is known as "The Magnificat." Why do you think that Mary burst into song?
- 12. Does Mary think that she was chosen because she was important? Why do you think that God chose Mary to be the mother of Jesus?
- 13. Verse 55 reminds us of a promise God made to Abraham. Read <u>Genesis 17:19</u>. How is that promise being fulfilled in Jesus?
