The Early Life of Jesus

The Bible does not record many details from the early life of Jesus. We know the family fled from Bethlehem to Egypt and later returned to Israel to live in Nazareth. In <u>Luke chapter 2:21-52</u> we read some incidents from the story of the early life of Jesus.

- 9. How did she react to Jesus?
- 10. Where did Mary and Joseph go after they had "fulfilled the requirements of the law?"
- 11. What do we learn about Jesus as a child from verses 40 and 52?
