The Gospel of Luke - Lesson 5

Luke 3:1-18;21-23

Introduction and Background

In this passage we learn about John the Baptist and what he said and did. Luke quotes from a passage in the Old Testament that predicted that John the Baptist would come preparing the way for Jesus. We also learn about the beginning of Jesus' ministry. Before He began His ministry, Jesus was trained as a carpenter and worked in Nazareth.

Read Luke 3:1-6

- 1. What year was it? Who were the rulers and high priests?
- 2. What was the message John was preaching?
- 3. Why do you think the people needed to be forgiven? Do we need forgiveness today?
- 4. Which Old Testament prophet had written about what John was doing?
- 5. What would be the role of the "voice shouting in the wilderness?"
- 6. What would people see in verse 6? What do you think that means?

Read <u>Luke 3:7-18</u>

- 7. How did John respond to the people that came to him for baptism?
- 8. Why do you think people thought they were safe because they were descended from Abraham?
- 9. How did the crowds respond to John's criticism? What did he say they should do?
- 10. Who were the people expecting to come soon? (verse 15) How did John describe Him? What did John say this person would do?
- 11. What kind of news was John giving to the people?

Read Luke 3:21-23

12. Who did John baptize? What happened when Jesus was baptized? Do you think this is important? Why? How old was Jesus at this time?
