The Gospel of Luke - Lesson 6

Luke 3; 21-38; Luke 4:1-13

Introduction and Background

In this passage we discover Jesus' family tree, including some of His famous ancestors from the Old Testament. The list of ancestors goes back for many generations, all the way to Adam. We also learn about how old He was when he began His public ministry. In addition, the 4th chapter of Luke tells us the story of how Jesus was challenged by Satan in the desert before He started to preach and perform miracles.

Warm Up

Who are you descended from? How many generations back can you go? How do you think it would be possible for Jewish people to know their ancestors for so many generations?

- 6. Where did Jesus go? Why do you think He went there? How long was He there?
- 7. Do you think it is possible for a person to survive so long without food?
- 8. What does the devil try to get Jesus to do, and how does Jesus respond? (verses 3-4)
- 9. What does the devil try to get Jesus to do, and how does Jesus respond? (verses 5-8)
- 10. What does the devil try to get Jesus to do, and how does Jesus respond? (verses 9-11)
- 11. Do you see a relationship between these 3 sections and what Jesus says in verse 12?
- 12. What does the devil do next? (verse 13)
- 13. Why do you think Jesus refused when the devil offered Him all the kingdoms of the world? What would you do?
- 14. Why do you think that Jesus chose to fast for so long?

15. What advice are followers of Jesus given in this verse? Do you think this is possible?
