Section 1 [Read Genesis 3:1-7](#)

1. Is it possible for a snake to speak? Who do you think was talking through the snake?
2. What do you think was the serpent's motive when he began the conversation with "Did God really say...?"
3. What sin does Satan commit? How does Jesus describe Satan in [John 8:44](#)?
4. How did Eve respond to the serpent? Was it right or wrong for the woman to eat the fruit?
5. How did Adam respond to his wife? What did they do when they saw they were naked? How are their feelings different from [Genesis 2:25](#)?

Section 2 [Read Genesis 3:8-13](#)

6. What changes do you see in the relationship between God and mankind when you compare [Genesis 2:19-22](#) with [Genesis 3:8](#)?
7. How do we usually feel and react after we sin and are found out?
8. Who does Adam blame? Who does Eve blame? Who is really to blame?

Section 3 [Read Genesis 3:14-20](#)

9. God places curses on Adam, Eve, and the serpent. How does He curse the snake? What is the result of the woman's sin? How does God punish the man? Are these curses present today?
10. What was the most serious punishment described in verse 19? Why do you think that God did not punish Adam and Eve with physical death immediately?

11. After Adam and Eve realized that they had sinned, they tried to cover themselves with fig leaves. What did God replace those coverings with?
12. What do you think God was teaching Adam and Eve about the relationship between sin and death?

13. What does Jesus say about death and life? Do you believe it is possible to have eternal life? If you knew that you had eternal life, how would it change the way that you think and live now?
